## Computer Use Agreement

- 2. You must have permission from a teacher to access the internet and what you are searching for must be agreed by the teacher.
- 3. You must have permission from a teacher to send emails/messages.
- 4. If you send an email/message you must not include your full name, your telephone number or any part of your address.
- 5. You must not download any files from the internet without permission from your teacher.
- 6. All children will participate in e-safety lessons to ensure they are aware of the benefits and dangers of internet use.
- 7. ICT equipment and software will be treated with respect and never used to hurt, embarrass or ridicule others.
- 8. All children will be made aware of cyberbullying. Any concerns involving pupils from school and social network sites will be investigated and appropriate action taken, including Police involvement, where necessary.
- 9. Parents and children <u>will not</u> post material deemed to be inappropriate or offensive to the school Facebook or web page.
- 10. Parents will **monitor and review** their child's online activity and support the school where issues relating to online activity have an impact in school.
- 11. Parents who allow their children access to social media before the recommended age, do so at their **own risk**.
- 12. Parents will not contact pupils of school using social media sites or mobile technology to deal with disputes but will seek support from school to resolve any issues involving school pupils.
