## General Uniform Reminders

School Uniform Policy is for **no jewellery** apart from small earrings (plain studs) which must be removed for all PE lessons for health and safety reasons. Watches may be worn but must be removed for PE and extra-curricular activities.

Please note that children in Reception and Nursery must not wear earrings as they spend a lot of their time in active play.

Smart black hard wearing flat shoes – no trainers, no flossies. If warm boots are worn to school in the winter they need to be black. Plimsolls are provided for children to change into if they do not come in to school wearing the appropriate footwear.

False nails should not be worn to school.
