Results of Parental Questionnaire 2015

Thank you to all the parents / carers who contributed to the parents' survey we conducted. Your comments have provided us with valuable research into our performance across the school.

The aim of the survey was to assess how satisfied parents are with the various aspects of school life, and make suggestions for ways in which to improve the school further. Overall we had 68 families respond from a total of 235 (29%). The overwhelming majority of parents (95%) either strongly agreed or agreed with the questions asked, with 2% either disagreeing or strongly disagreeing with the questions asked and 3 % answering 'do not know'.

100% of parents strongly agreed and agreed with the following questions:-

My child is happy at Holy Trinity.

My child has friends at school.

There is a happy atmosphere at school.

The school buildings are well maintained.

The school site is sufficiently secure.

Holy Trinity is helping my child become self-confident and responsible.

Members of staff at Holy Trinity are approachable.

From the analysis attached you can see that there were a high percentage of parents answering 'do not know' to the following questions:-

The school's system of discipline is effective.

School reports provide me with the information I require about my child's progress and achievement.

The school website and facebook pages provide clear information regarding what has happened in school and also about future events.

However the high percentage of answers were mainly from parents of nursery children who had just started school and who felt that they could not answer the questions appropriately.

As always your written comments are also welcome. The following are some of the parental comments received:-
