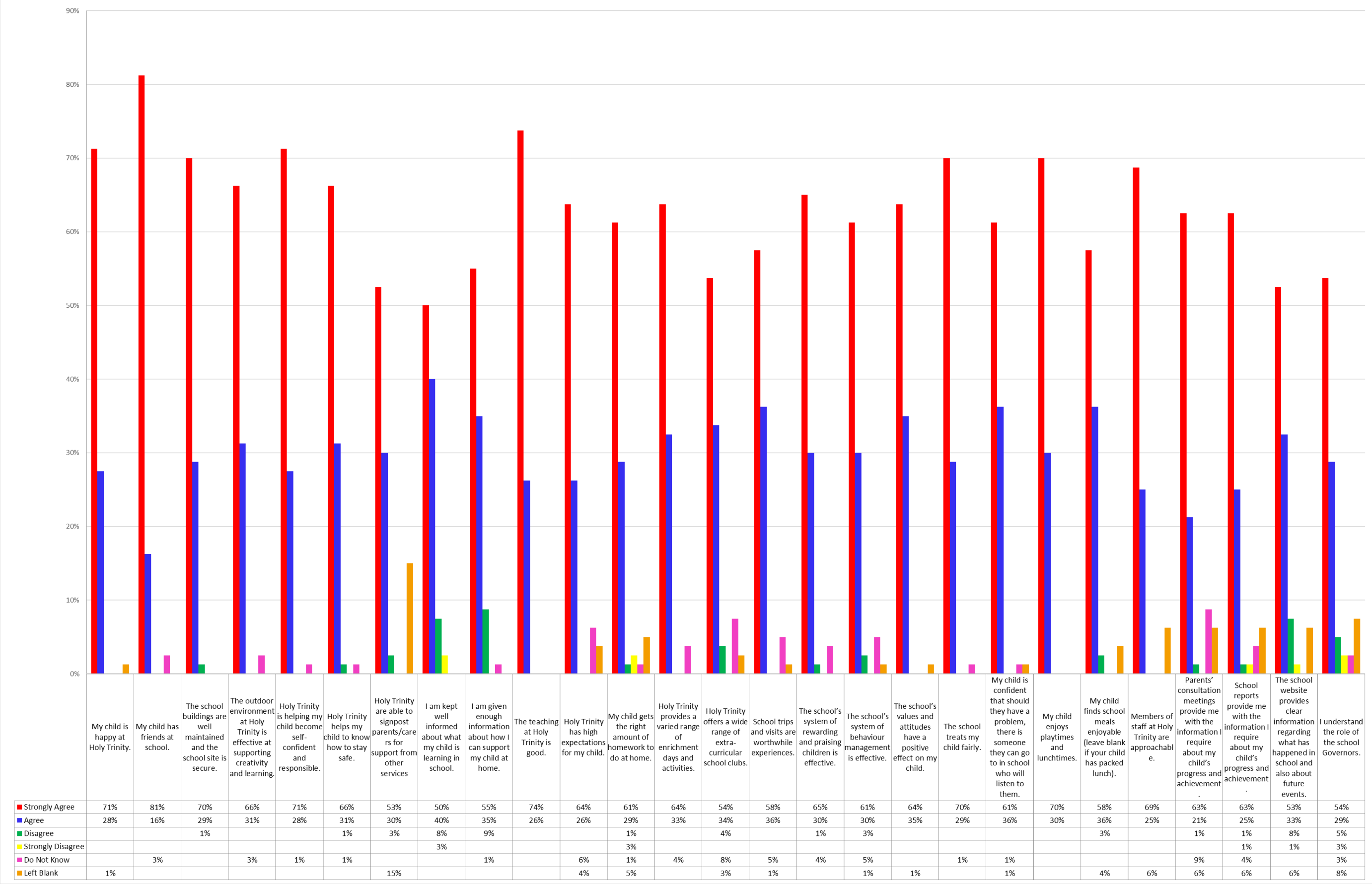

This is understandable but not really helping us support him with homework. My child has no problems but I don't want him to feel as though he is struggling when we can't explain it correctly. I think the amount of homework my child gets is too much. My child has a lot of after school clubs and with family on a weekend, I sometimes feel that they don't want to do it.

The only thing I have to comment on would be in Nursery/Reception I could see what my child was learning/doing not really aware so much in year 1.

Great School, Great Staff! The only thing I would like to say I disagree with is the handing out of vouchers at classroom doors on pick up, a few parents have said that this is degrading to low income families, much better when pick up was from school office.

Holy Trinity is a very good school which always puts the needs of the children first. Both the teaching and the values of the school are the best I have known.

Not always enjoyable lunchtimes as doesn't like choices and made to eat.

My child is struggling with school dinners and is telling myself that she doesn't eat much. I have asked for school nurses help as this is also issue outside of school.

My child has improved massively since starting Holy Trinity.

We do have one small problem. Some of the parents in the school yard use foul language and our child has picked up on that.

One mam told me a staff member told her about it during Covid 2020. Also I feel very reassured and confident about the staff, teachers, TA's, receptionists, welfare officer and even dinner staff. My child knows every member of staff and speaks highly of them all. I am so glad we chose Holy Trinity School.
