Dear Parents and Carers,

As you will know the last day of half term ends on Friday 12th February and pupils will return on Wednesday 24th February 2021

Like you, we are looking forward to the holidays, but we are keen to continue to follow government advice - as we have done through every stage of the COVID-19 pandemic.

We have been asked to remind parents and carers to use our local testing facility this week for any children who are displaying symptoms and to inform school of a positive test result as soon as possible. Using the local testing facility will help speed up the results rather than opting for a home testing kit. The best way to book a test is to telephone 119 or visit <https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test>. We are not aware of any problems with capacity currently in getting a test at a test centre.

We have also been asked to ensure staff, parents and carers are aware of the following information and relevant arrangements regarding positive cases in the holidays:

- For the first 6 days after teaching ends, if a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school.
- School staff are not asked to remain on-call or conduct any contact tracing more than 6 days after the final day of teaching. As our last day in school is Thursday 18th February 2021 there should be no pupil contact tracing beyond Friday 19th February 2021.
