30 hours FREE childcare for 3 and 4 year olds



Information for parents

Your child could be entitled to 30 hours of **FREE** childcare per week during term time.

All 3 and 4 year olds are currently entitled to 15 hours **FREE** childcare per week. However from September 2017 working parents* of 3 and 4 year olds could be entitled to an additional 15 hours of **FREE** childcare.

*The additional 15 hours of **FREE** childcare is available for families where both parents are working (or the sole parent isworking in a sole parent family), and each parent is earning the equivalent of 16 hours per week minimum at the national minimum or living wage.

15 hours FREE childcare for 2 year olds



Your child may be entitled to 15 hours per week of Free Nursery Education funding starting the term after their second birthday.

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Universal Credit, and your household income is £15,400 a year or less after tax, not including benefit payments
- Child tax credits, and your household income is £16,190 a year or less before tax
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- The Working Tax Credit 4-week run on (the payment you get when you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

2-year-olds can also get free childcare if they:

- Are looked after by a local authority
- Have a statement of special education needs (SEN) or an education, health and care (EHC) plan
- Get Disability Living Allowance
- Have left care under an adoption order, special guardianship order or a child arrangements order
